Tournament General Information

Primed 4 Sports is proud to announce the FireStix College Exposure Tournament for ages **14u**,**16u**,**18u**.

Date: June 25th-28th

Tournament Fee: 14u \$900 "1 umpire for pool play 2 for bracket"

16u & 18u **\$1100** "2 umpires for all games"

Refund Policy: No refunds will be given to teams that withdraw after registration & payment. Unless the tournament director can replace your team from the waiting list. Refund Policy: Once tournament begins a 60% refund will be given if 0 games are played due to weather. If 1 game is played to completion the tournament fee is fully earned and no refunds will be given. If the tournament is canceled due to an act of God prior to the start date a 70% refund of your entry fee will be awarded.

This tournament is a **5-game** guarantee! (Weather Permitting).

Lodging: This event is a stay to play policy. If reserving hotel rooms, they must be done through **TRAVELING TEAMS** to ensure your acceptance into the tournament. Local teams traveling inside the 70-mile radius are exempt. If you reserve rooms outside of the Traveling Teams hotel list your team will be charged \$225 before being allowed to play in the event.

The FireStix Tournament will use college exposure umpires and PGF rules with college exposure exceptions. Also, in attendance will be the Midwest college coaches. A compiled list of coaches attending will be available on the website as they commit.



Tournament Rules

All players and coaches are expected to follow the Michigan & Tournament guidelines to keep us all safe. All teams must turn in proof of team insurance either by email or before the start of the first games. We will follow PGF rules with some college exposure exceptions. Home team will be determined with a coin flip by umpires prior to the start of games. Be prepared to start early if the situation allows. No infield practice between games. The report of scores will be TEXT by the winning team or by the FireStix College Exposure work staff.

Line-Ups

Pool Play- Pool games are exposure games and wins and losses do not affect seeding. You may bat the entire roster and freely substitute on "offense or defense" and make changes in order to give your athletes maximum exposure.

Bracket Play- Bracket play you may still bat the roster if you choose but NO free substitution on "offense" as described in pool play games. If batting the rosters you may sub freely on defense but not on offense.

If a team decides to bat the entire line-up and an injury occurs to a player and that player is unable to continue, that player's spot in the batting line-up will be recorded as an out. Courtesy runners are allowed for pitcher/catcher only! The runner must be a player not currently in the batting line-up. If batting the roster the player who made the most recent out must be the runner. If both catcher and pitcher reach base in the same inning and a 2^{nd} courtesy runner is needed, the out before the most recent should be used. The same player shall not be the courtesy runner in the same inning.

Mercy Rule

12 runs after 3 innings – **10** runs after **4** innings- **8** runs after 5 innings. Run rule will apply to both pool play and bracket play. All pitching distance is 43ft.

Warm-Ups Before Games & Innings

All teams will be allowed to warm up behind temporary fencing before their scheduled game. We have additional warm up areas on off-site locations as well. First inning each team will be allowed 3 warm-up pitches and 1 throw down by the catcher. Infield & outfield warm up in the first inning only. We are looking to keep games on time and play as many innings as possible. No stall tactics will be tolerated! Play will resume quickly allowing teams the opportunity to play 7 innings.

Time Limit for Pool Play

All pool games will be one **hour twenty minutes** drop dead! Games **DO NOT** revert to the previous inning. Pool games are exposure games and wins and losses do not affect your bracket seeding. No tiebreaker for pool games. Game will end in a tie!

Time Limit for Bracket Play

No new inning may start after **one hour thirty minutes** even if teams have not reached the 5th inning. Finish the inning if time expires and the inning already has started. All tied games after the time limit or 7 innings has expired will use international tie breaker.

Tournament Advancement

Each age division will be broken into pools of 5 teams. Each team will play 4 pool games before being blind drawn into a **Single Elimination Championship Bracket.** Winners play until we have a champion in each age division! Tournament game scores will be kept on Tourney Machine ONLY! Please refrain from coming up to the main tent. We will update Tourney Machine ASAP. It is your responsibility to check Tourney Machine to know your correct times and fields. Especially critical during bracket play advancement.

Sportsmanship will be Strictly Enforced.

No inappropriate behavior will be tolerated. All games are to be played in a respectful manner towards players, coaches, umpires, and fans. No profanity will be accepted. Tournament director and Umpire-in-Chief will have final authority on all matters regarding a game dispute. Any ejections! Your next game will be sat out! We have a responsibility as coaches to set the example of proper game conduct.

On Site Team Registration

This is a non-sanction event. All teams must send proof of insurance or turn in before the start of the first pool game at the site directors tent. Please have your players contact any D-1, D-2 NAIA, Division 3 and Juco college coaches that may be interested.

IN CASE OF RAIN

The Tournament Director may have to adjust the schedule! This procedure will not be debatable. Tourney Machine will aid us if rain becomes a concern. Our main purpose is to give you an extremely competitive and enjoyable tournament. Your team and players will come first in all our decision process and we will do everything we can to get all games in. Although Pool Play does not affect Bracket play seeding substantial rain may affect how many teams are allowed in the bracket and we may take the top in each pools to finish the tournament. We want to thank all teams participating and we look forward to meeting all of you.
